This is information for a student-athlete scholarship opportunity. The National Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association (NIAAA) is offering this scholarship opportunity for deserving student-athletes around our country. Each year, Maryland has had many outstanding applicants and several have gone on to be selected as the NIAAA Section 2 winner. We have even had three NIAAA National winners as well.

There is an NIAAA fillable application with this information. Your school athletic administrator was emailed this information, also.

Everything must be submitted electronically and received by February 22, 2025 to cmsatterwhite@verizon.net If a hard copy must be sent, it must be postmarked no later than February 22, 2025 and sent to MSADA, c/o Carol M. Satterwhite, CAA, 5467 Gloucester Rd., Columbia, MD 21044.

Criteria:

- 1. Applicant must be a true senior (4 years, 8 semesters)
- 2. Applicant must have achieved at least one (1) of the following: (a) minimum of B+ average (b) ranked in the top 25% of class, (c) ACT score of 24 or SAT score of 1100 (Math and Reading)
- 3. Applicant must have participated in two (2) sports for a least two (2) years in each sport
- 4. Applicant must have earned at least one (1) varsity letter in each of the two (2) sports
- 5. Applicant must complete and include the scholar/essay
- 6. Applicant must have a letter of recommendation from their high school athletic administrator/director
- 7. The school athletic director must be an NIAAA member and a member of the MSADA, their state athletic administrators/directors' association
- 8. The principal or athletic director must sign the application to ensure that the academic information submitted is accurate
- 9. Everything must be submitted electronically and received by **February 22**, **2025** to **cmsatterwhite@verizon.net**. If a hard copy must be sent, it must be postmarked no later than **February 22**, **2025** and sent to **MSADA**, **c/o Carol M. Satterwhite**, **CAA**, **5467 Gloucester Rd.**, **Columbia**, **MD 21044**.

Scholarship Awards:

State Winners - if selected the male and female will each receive a plaque recognizing them as a state winner and \$500 from the MSADA

NIAAA Section Winners - if selected the male and/or female will receive a \$1500 scholarship and a plaque recognizing them as a section winner

National Winners - if selected the male and/or female will receive a \$2500 scholarship and a glass etching recognizing them as a national winner, in addition to attending the National Conference for Athletic Administrators in December to present their essay.
